MICADO – Digital Solution for Migration Challenges 2 June 2022

To answer this question, Digital City Science from HafenCity University (HCU) Hamburg showcases the results of the Horizon 2020 project MICADO, which was successfully piloted in Hamburg, Antwerp, Bologna and Madrid in 2021. After the platform's live demonstration, a roundtable with representatives of the European Commission, European cities and civil society organisations will outline the requirements for the successful local uptake of digital solutions developed in EU-funded projects.

MICADO stands for "Migrant Integration Cockpits and Dashboards" and is a H2020 project that aims at facilitating the arrival process of migrants with a digital solution. The web-based MICADO platform was developed in a co-creative process by a Pan-European consortium over the past three years, and eventually piloted with local stakeholders in Antwerp, Bologna, Madrid and Hamburg.

Digital City Science is an interdisciplinary and international research group at HCU that explores urban complexity with digital technologies. The team develops scientific approaches and data-based tools for the analysis and integrative planning of urban systems in cooperation with partners from academia, business, administration, and civil society. The tools and methodologies are broadly applied in the national and international context.
